

Rules and Instructions for Participation at the Hawken Classic 2024

1. Period camps only on the museum's lawn. Anything prior to the end of the Civil War is acceptable. Revolutionary War, French and Indian War, and Civil War periods are all acceptable. 1820-1860 is the goal period for the event.
2. This is a Living History event and is open to the public and family oriented. We ask that all participants dress in period clothing that is modest and use language throughout the event that is appropriate for children.
3. Campsites and Vendors should be set up on Wednesday or Thursday, May 15th, or 16th, between 8am on Wednesday and Friday at 8:30am. The event opens to the public at 10am on Friday, May 17, 2024.
4. All Vendors will be in the open area between the boat ramp and the museum.
5. All Period Camps will be in the open grass area directly around the museum.
6. No campfires on the ground, except at the designated common firepit area. Elevated campfires only.
7. All campfires need to be monitored anytime they are lit. Do not leave fires unattended.
8. Missouri firewood can be used at the park. Firewood from other states is prohibited.
9. All guns must be checked and tagged. Tags indicate the gun is empty and can be carried around the property by living history participants. Guns displayed in the museum do not require tags.
10. Pick up your badge and paperwork at the registration desk on Wednesday or Thursday before the event begins.
11. All participants should wear their **GREEN** badge so that we can see clearly if anyone from the public is staying after hours. Your name badge will provide unlimited access to the museum.
12. Volunteers will have **RED** name tags. If you need any help or have questions, please check with one of the 60 or so volunteers that will be at the park.
13. NO lead/ammunition is allowed on the property. Black powder blanks are only allowed at the firing line area. Firing is to be directed towards the river.
14. Follow all rules as presented by the range officers at the firing line.
15. If you are a Seminar speaker, please meet under the Museum at least 15 minutes before your presentation start time. We will have a table there for any items that you want to use during your presentation. We will have a microphone and speakers' setup so that everyone in the pavilion can hear the presentations. We will also have a large screen TV with an HDMI connection for presenters to utilize.
16. Vendors in the open tents CAN move valuable items under the museum into the locked and gated area at the end of each day so that they can be locked up and secure.
17. Vendors will be serving food during the event, located in the parking lot.
18. Drinking water will be available from a spigot near the museum.
19. The Information tent will be the center point for all questions throughout the event.
20. Ice will be available onsite with 20# bags of ice for \$5.
21. Alcohol IS allowed on museum property outside of public hours.
22. NO sale of alcohol is allowed.
23. NO alcohol is allowed in the parking lot in front of the museum.
24. There are indoor restrooms inside the museum that are open to all participants. Your badge will give you access to the museum. There will also be port-a-potties and wash stations located outside, by the parking lot, for everyone's use.
25. Vendor Fee: \$40, Camp Fee: \$15, Trade Blanket Fee: \$10. Camps and vendor fees include up to 2 people. \$5 per person for extra people in camps and vendor tents. Ice will be available for \$5 per 20# bag.
